

Izložbe Etnografskoga muzeja u Zagrebu 2006. – 2007.

Tijekom 2006. i 2007. Etnografski muzej u Zagrebu predstavio se posjetiteljima predmetima iz svog fundusa i gostujućim izložbama koje su obuhvatile nacionalnu, europsku i izvaneuropsku građu.

Prikupljano znanje o predmetima i određenim temama prenosili smo promatraču na različite načine, ne samo izlošcima i njihovim posrednim i neposrednim značenjima, već i tumačenjem simbola koji predstavljaju određene fenomene. Građu smo predstavili kroz povijesne, etnološke, sociološke i kulturološke vidove.

Živimo u vremenu kada je razmjena informacija i znanja i u urbanoj i u ruralnoj kulturi vrlo dinamična i nužno je određene teme interpretirati ne samo stručno i znanstveno, već ih postaviti i u kontekst suvremenih mijena. Stoga je muzejskim izložbama baština problematizirana u interakciji s tradicijskom i suvremenom pojavnosti.

I protekle godine Muzej je nastavio s prikazivanjem tzv. duhovne tradicije, kao dijela kulturne baštine čija je pokretljivost, pa time i mogućnost asimilacije odnosno zatiranja, uočljiva. Izložbama pokušavamo održavati još postojeću živu izvornu tradiciju i na taj je način nastojimo sačuvati u individualnom i kolektivnom sjećanju.

Muzej se, osim prikazivanja već uobičajenih tema običaja, pozabavio temom glazbe i glazbala ne samo kao fizičkim i duhovnim predmetima, već i kao simbolom identiteta.

Tema hrane i prehrane prikazana je na izložbi i kroz nekoliko pristupa i u nekoliko poglavlja.

Uz izložbe u 2006. godini održano je četrdeset i sedam pedagoških radionica, dok su tijekom 2007. godine održane šezdeset i dvije edukativne radionice.

KOJE DOBRE ŠUZE – šetnja kroz povijest obuće, 16.2.– 4.6.2006.

Izložbom je predstavljen razvoj obuće, od pretpovijesti do danas. Osim namjene, pojašnjeni su kulturološki, gospodarski i politički čimbenici koji su utjecali na razvoj obuće na određenim prostorima i u određenim razdobljima.

Izložba se održavala u okviru muzejsko-edukativne nagradne igre Zvuk ... ton ... glas, postavljene povodom Međunarodnog dana muzeja. Izložba je propitivala tamburicu kroz povijest i sadašnjost kao glazbalo i kao simbol hrvatskoga identiteta.

GLAZBA I IDENTITET, Berlin, 26.8.– 29.9.2006.

U sklopu Dana hrvatske kulture u Muzeju europskih kultura u Berlinu Etnografski muzej postavio je izložbu *Glazba i identiteti*, koja je bila otvorena u okviru manifestacije “Duge noći berlinskih muzeja”.

Izložbom su predstavljena tradicijska glazbala iz fundusa Etnografskog muzeja kao sastavni dio tradicijskoga glazbovanja, a koja ujedno predstavljaju simbole hrvatskoga identiteta ili ga problematiziraju. Izložba je ispričala priču o bogatoj povijesti i nacionalnoj vrijednosti glazbala kao izrazu regionalnih i lokalnih identiteta, o znanstvenim interpretacijama tamburice i glazbe, te o načinima suvremene uporabe instrumenta kao suvenira i kao dijela organiziranih oblika zabave suvremenog društva (etno-glazba).

Izložbu je pratio film *Kuterevska dangubica* koji se, između ostalog, pozabavio i zvukom tamburice kao segmentom duhovne baštine.

skulpturom, slikom, uporabnim tekstilom i dekorativnim eksponatima profanog karaktera, u vremenskom i geografskom slijedu. 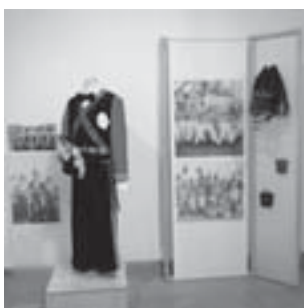

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Review
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Exhibitions in the Ethnographic Museum in Zagreb in 2006 and 2007

During the last two years the museum has presented itself to its visitors with items from its collections and visiting exhibitions which have encompassed national, European and non-European objects.

The knowledge we gathered about the items and the specific themes we have transferred to the observer in different ways, not only with exhibits and their direct and indirect meanings but also by interpreting symbols that represent certain phenomena. We have presented the exhibits through historical, ethnological, sociological and cultural aspects. We live in a time when the exchange of information and knowledge runs very fast both in urban and in rural culture and it is necessary to interpret certain subjects not only competently and scientifically but also to put them in the context of contemporary changes, thus the Museum has presented heritage in interaction with the traditional and contemporary phenomena.

Last year too, the Museum has continued to exhibit the so-called spiritual tradition, as a part of the cultural heritage whose mobility is observable, and, thus also the possibility of its assimilation. We are trying to continue the still existing living original tradition and in this way preserve it in individual and collective memory.

Besides showing the usual thematic of folk customs, the Museum has taken up the subject of music and the instruments not only as a physical and spiritual object but also as a symbol of identity.

Forty-seven pedagogical workshops accompanied the exhibitions in 2006, while 62 educational workshops accompanied those in 2007.

WHAT A PAIR OF SHOES – a Walk Through the History of Footwear, February 16th – June 6th 2006.

The exhibition presented the development of footwear, from ancient history to the present day. Besides the usage, cultural, economic and political factors affecting the development of footwear in certain locations and periods were explained.

TAMBURITZA – a Symbol of Croatian Identity? April 20th – May 18th 2006.

The exhibition took place in the framework of the educational-museum competition Sound... tone... voice, created on the occasion of the international day of museums. The exhibition interpreted the tamburitza through past and present as a musical instrument and as a symbol of the Croatian identity. It was accompanied with a film about a tamburitza from

Kuterevo - *Kuterevska dangubica*.

The presentation was accompanied by music, from the traditional to the contemporary ethno music. Web pages about the ethno music scene in Croatia were also presented.

SVIJET HRANE U HRVATSKOJ (THE WORLD OF FOOD IN CROATIA),

December 12th 2006. – November 2nd 2007.

The exhibition was prepared in cooperation with the Institute of ethnology and folklore, and it encompassed the history of nutrition, Croatian traditional cuisine, and customs and the traditional ways of preparing food.

A part of the exhibition is an open exhibition devoted to cookbooks and recipes. The greater part of the exhibited books belongs to the collection of written cookbooks by the restaurant owner Zlatko Puntijar from Zagreb. This part of the exhibition was opened on January 26th 2007 as a part of the 'Night of the museums' manifestation.

I COSTUMI TRADIZIONALI CROATI

(CROATIAN NATIONAL COSTUMES) Italy, July 10 - October 20 2006.

MUSIC AND IDENTITY, Berlin, August 26 - September 29 2006

Within the Days of Croatian culture in the museum of European cultures in Berlin the Ethnographic museum has set up an Exhibition *Music and identity* opened within the framework of the “Long night of the Berlin Museums”.

The exhibition presented traditional instruments from the collection of the ethnographical museum as of integral part of the traditional playing of music, which represent the symbols of Croatian identity or they question it. The exhibition has told a story about the rich history and national value of the instruments as an expression of the regional and local identities, about the scientific interpretations of the tamburitza and the music it produces, and about the ways of the contemporary usage of instruments as souvenirs and as a part of the organized forms of entertainment in the modern society (ethno-music). The exhibition was accompanied by a film *Kuterevska dangubica* which, among other things, dealt with the sound of tamburitza as a segment of spiritual heritage. The presentation was made complete with music, from the traditional to the contemporary ethno music. The web pages of the contemporary ethno music scene in Croatia were presented too.
